

Stained Glass Window Project Update

The Project began the week of July 23. The following is a general list of what will occur over the next 8 or so months.

1. 66 windows will receive new, properly ventilated, protective covering glass. The two windows that face into the women's restroom do not get exterior protective covering glass.
2. 24 windows will be removed and shipped to Associated Crafts Studio in Minnesota for restoration. 18 of those 24 are to be converted to single sash, which includes the lower floor windows facing North, and those in Pastor Chelsey's and Pastor Karen's offices.
3. The 6 windows above the altar were restored in 2013 and will only get outside maintenance as required, and new protective covering glass.
4. 8 windows that were restored circa 1995 will be cleaned on the interior in addition to outside maintenance.
5. The two large "rose" windows will be removed by section, re-cemented on site and re-placed.
6. Six of the windows in the main part of the sanctuary that are being restored, will have temporary transparencies installed while the windows are gone, so that it will appear like the windows are actually in place!!
